The beautifully uddered four-year-old had the style and conformation to catch the eye of Judge Larry Specht, Penn State dairy specialist, and repeat last year's performance as the supreme titlists in the dairy show.

Seeds' well-known home-bred Jersey herd has won at least 20 grand championships over the years. At the Mardis Gras celebration Tuesday evening, Seeds was honored for 30 years of livestock exhibitions at the Allentown Fair.

The Supreme champion in the small bull show was shown by Angie Brensinger for Hidden Acres. The champion came from the yearling class in the Milking Shorthorn show.

In the youth showmanship and fitting classes, Jarrod Johns won both classes in the FFA Division. Johns represents the Owen J. Roberts chapter.

In the 4-H Fitting show, Paul Plummer was the champion, and Tarik Gaffney, a first-year member, was reserve champion. Steven Dietrich was the champion showman, and Gaffney was also the reserve champion.

In the Brown Swiss show, Carl Miller had the junior champion and Russel Miller had the reserve junior champion. Russel also had the grand champion, and Frank Miller had the reserve grand champion.

Carl D. Miller had all the senior and grand champions in the Guernsey show. And Karen Wolfgang had both the junior and the reserve junior champions.

In the Holstein show, Steven Dietrich had all the senior and grand champions, as well as the reserve junior champion. Stacy Dietrich had the junior champion.

In the Jersey show, Mildred Seeds had all the senior and grand

champions, as well as the bull champion. Paul Plummer had the junior champion, and Tarik Gaffney had the reserve junior champion.

Hidden Acres had all the junior, senior and grand champions in the Milking Shorthorn show.

Seth Wolfgang had the grand champion Ayrshire; Craig Nolan had the junior champion, and Heath Miller had the reserve champion.

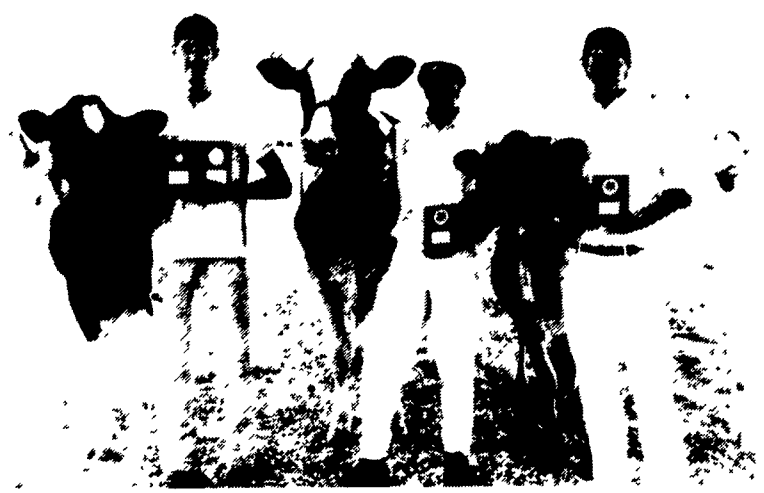
