

# Two Counties Dominate 4-H Events At Maryland Fair

Kluka was one of 10 Baltimore County 4-H'ers to win champion or reserve champion honors in the Indoor events competition.

COLLEGE PARK, Md. — 4-H members from Baltimore and Carroll counties dominated the indoor events at the Maryland State Fair in Timonium, winning champion and reserve champion ribbons in a total of 20 categories.

Seven 4-H'ers from Carroll County took top honors in nine individual events, while the Carrollton 4-H Club received the highest award for their booth exhibit promoting 4-H, which judges praised for its large component figures and eye-catching colors.

Jaime Baile, 13, of Union Bridge led the way with championship entries in junior art and crafts categories. Her detailed black-and-white pencil portrait and paper mache vegetables arranged in a basket captivated the judges.

Kieth Dutterer, 11, Westminster, also earned recognition for his entries in two categories. He was named champion in the grain category for his barley and reserve champion in the intermediate food preparation category for his pink-

and-white angel food cake.

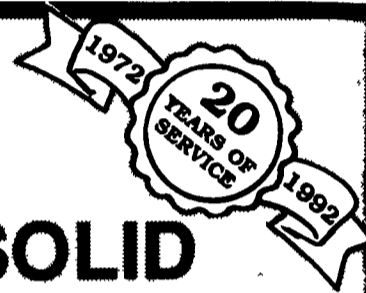
Other Carroll County champions were: Cheryl Owings, 12, of Union Bridge in the intermediate

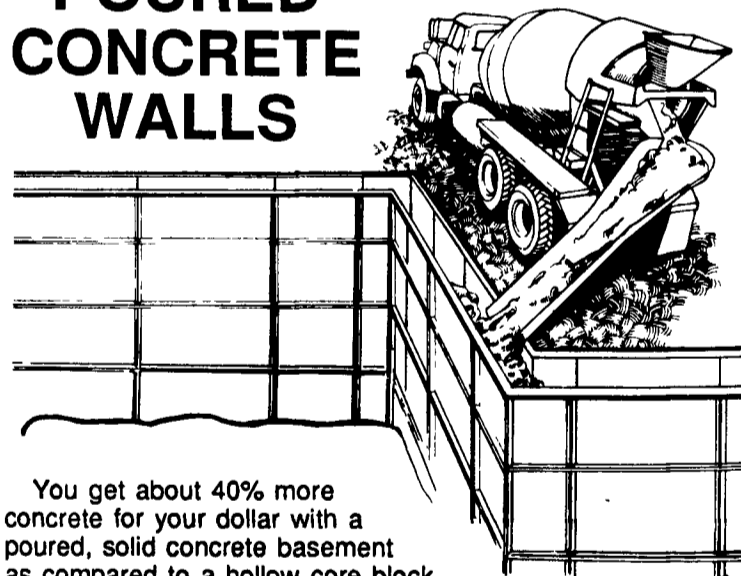

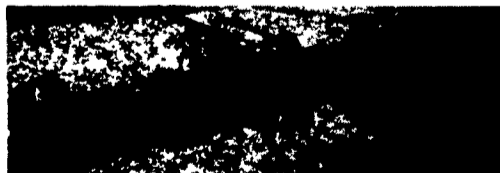
