

All American Hosts Many Shows, Sales

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — Six open shows with great cattle, thousands of youth competing for ribbons and scholarship monies, three national breed sales, and an industry in the East will headline activities at the 29th Annual Pennsylvania All-American Dairy Show in Harrisburg.

The first official event will be the Pennsylvania Dairy Princess Pageant at the Sheraton Harrisburg East on Saturday, Sept. 19. Tickets are available by contacting the PA Dairy Princess Program, 214 South Street, PO Box 640, Clarion, PA 16214.

On Sunday night, Sept. 20, the Pennsylvania Dairy Promotion Program and the American Dairy Association and Dairy Council will join the All-American hosting Careers and Opportunities Night. This college career night gives dairy youth a chance to meet faculty from about 12 colleges and universities in the Front Lobby of the Farm Show Complex.

The program for Monday, Sept. 21 starts at 8 a.m. with the Invitational Youth Dairy Cattle Judging

Contest Awards Banquet at the Sheraton Harrisburg East. At the same time, the bidding gets underway in the Invitational Brown Swiss Sale in the Small Arena of the Farm Show Complex.

On Tuesday, Sept. 22, the Eastern National Brown Swiss Show and the Eastern National Milking Shorthorn Show take center stage in the Large Arena at 9 a.m. Meanwhile, dairy youth will be preparing for the Junior Dairyman Contest and the Pennsylvania 4-H and FFA Dairy Judging Forum that start promptly at 10 a.m. Later, at 1 p.m., the Pennsylvania Elite Ayrshire Sale will fill the Small Arena.

On Sept. 23 at 9 a.m., the National Guernsey Show and the Eastern National Ayrshire Show will be in the spotlight of the Large Arena. At 10 a.m. in the Small Arena, the 1992 Jersey Harvest Futurity will select the winner.

In the late afternoon of the third day, dairymen will gather and pause for a moment of fellowship and camaraderie at the annual Herdsman's Buffet hosted in the Small Arena. Following the buffet, the annual Eastern National Holstein Sale will auction off more than 60 lots starting at 7 p.m.

The final day of the 29th annual Pennsylvania All-American Dairy Show will kick off at 8 a.m. with the Eastern National Holstein Show and the Mid-Atlantic Regional Jersey Show in the Large Arena.

Highlighting the week's activities will be the selection of the supreme champion in mid-afternoon.

In addition to the shows, competitions and contests, there will be over 40 commercial exhibitors participating in the show. There will also be the dairy hospitality station each day near the Large Arena.


