Auction To Benefit Relief Projects

LEBANON (Lebanon Co.) — You can join in an action-packed, two-day event to raise funds for victims of disaster in the United States and around the world.

The 16th annual Church of the Brethren Disaster Relief Auction will be held Friday and Saturday, September 25 and 26, at the Lebanon Area Fairgrounds, three miles south of Lebanon off Route 72.

A monetary goal of \$330,000 has been set for this event, sponsored by the 112 churches of the Atlantic Northeast and southern Pennsylvania districts of the Church of the Brethren. Year-round efforts of many volunteer workers, donated items, and thousands of auction attendees will help to make this possible.

Friday evening, September 25, begins with a worship service at 6 p.m. At 7 p.m., an auction of approximately 75 head of registered and grade heifers will be held as well as an auction of a variety of items. Saturday's auction will begin at 8:30 a.m., with Winross trucks auctioned at 10 a.m., approximately 100 handstitched quilts auctioned at 10:30 a.m., and baseball cards at 1:30 p.m. During the two days, various paintings by local artists, furniture, and many handcrafted items will be sold.

There will be a farmer's market of fresh produce starting at 6 p.m. on Friday and 8 a.m. on Saturday. A variety of homemade foods will be available both days, including approximately 1,000 pies, soups, apple dumplings, and pot pie. In addition, there will be more than 60 craft vendors displaying and selling items.

In 1991, monies from the Church of the Brethren Emergency Disaster Fund aided people in many regions, including Sudan, Haiti, the Middle East, the former USSR, Puerto Rico. California, Texas, and
