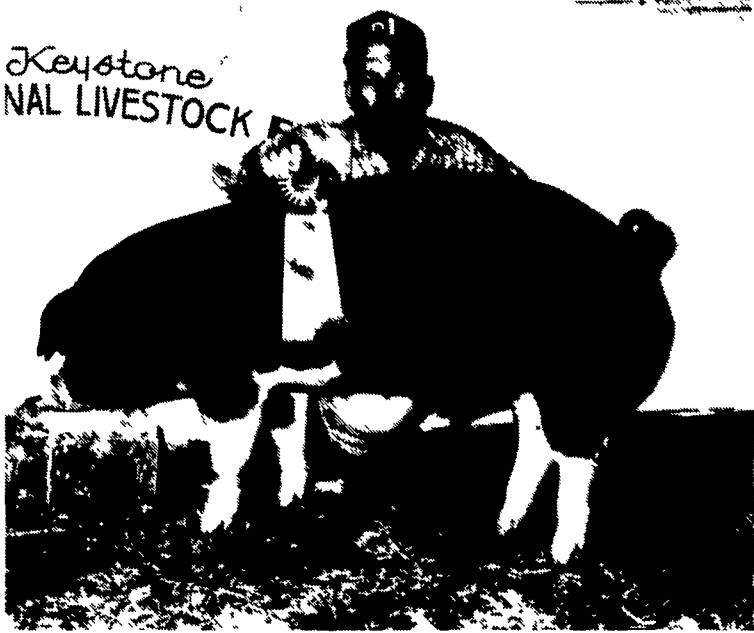
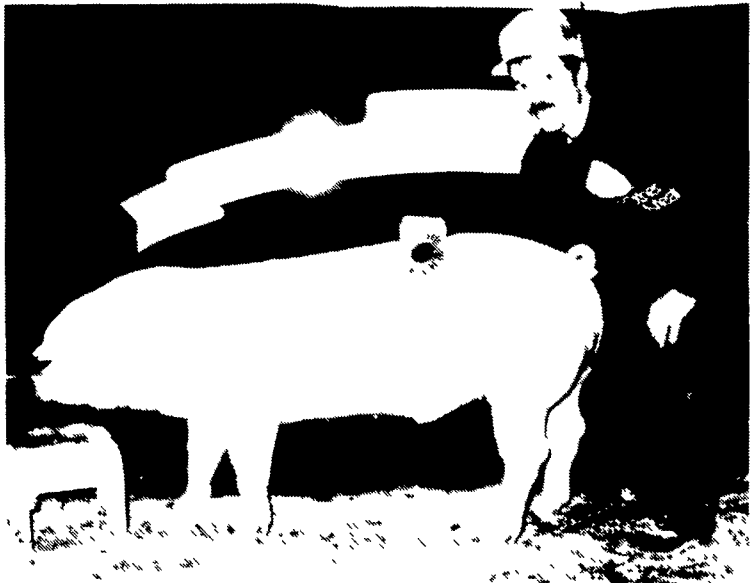


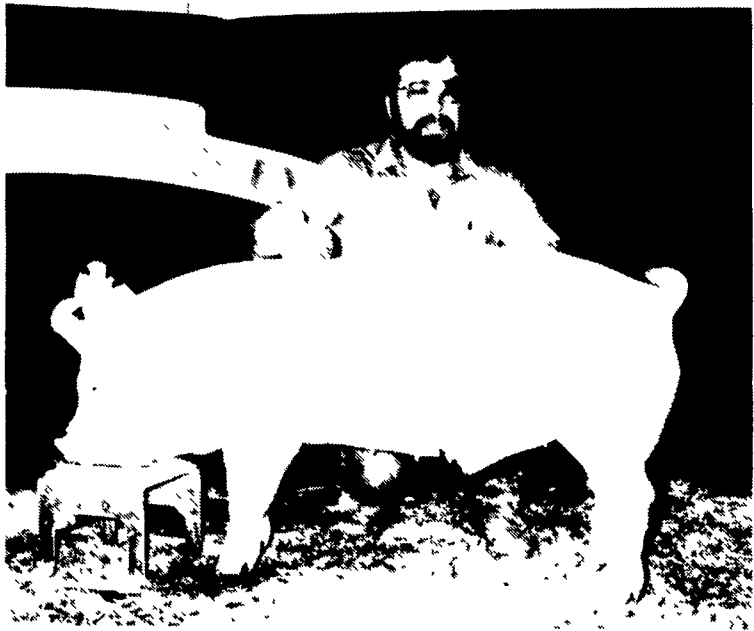
Pa. Takes Most Titles At KILE Breeding Swine Shows
