

Conestoga Christian School To Hold 19th Auction

MORGANTOWN (Berks Co.) — Conestoga Christian School has scheduled its 19th annual Country Auction and chicken barbeque for Friday, Oct. 16, and Saturday, Oct. 17, at the school, on Rte. 23, one mile west of Morgantown.

Activities will begin Friday, Oct. 16, with a chicken barbeque from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m. Chicken halves or full chicken dinners — including chicken half, apple-sauce, roll and butter, fruit cup, chips, whoopie pie, and drink — may be taken out or eaten in the gymnasium. Tickets for the dinner may be secured by calling the school office at (215) 286-0353.

Friday's events will also include a craft sale and a display of the quilts that will be sold the following day.

A pancake and sausage breakfast is the first event slated for Saturday, Oct. 18. The breakfast will be from 6:30 to 10 a.m. in the

lower level of Conestoga Mennonite Church, across the road from the school.

The auction itself will begin in the school gymnasium at 9:30 a.m. and continue well into the afternoon.

Highlights will include the sale of the following items at the following items:

— 11 a.m., unique gift baskets made by each class of the kindergarten through 12th grade school;

— Noon, a grandfather's clock and hand-crafted chest, both custom-made by local residents, and a 1987 maroon Plymouth Horizon with only 57,000 miles on it and featuring an automatic transmission and an AM-FM radio/cassette player.

— 1 p.m., hand-made quilts and wall-hangings contributed by members of several area churches.

Silent auction bids on selected items will also be taken, through 1 p.m.

Other items to be auctioned include the following: packaged hamburger; packaged prime cuts of corn-fed beef; dressed turkeys for Thanksgiving; a paintings by local artists Jere Brady and Ruth Horning; Hershey Bears and Reading Phillies tickets; a hand-made marble roller; a hand-made gazebo bird feeder, woodshavings, a seven-foot-long picnic table; a 1992 edition Longaberger cake basket; firewood; a dog-

house; a dollhouse; a camper from Stoltzfus RV; and Conestoga Christian School 40th anniversary mugs.

Additional items offered for sale will include certificates from local businesses, for everything from restaurants and home-cooked meals to horseshoeing and glider rides.

Also, food stands will be serving refreshments and lunches

throughout the day. Among the food treats to be featured this year are: pizza, baked potatoes, soups, barbeque, apple dumplings, pie, ice cream, and drinks.
