PURPOSE The Maryland Holstein Futurity is a project of the Maryland Holstein Association to stimulate in-terest in the breeding and exhibiting of outstanding Registered Holsteins in Maryland if recognizes the ac complishments of the smell and the large breeder and the FFA and 4 H boy or girl

PROCEDURE The 1995 Maryland Futurity, is to be designated No 12 and each succeeding numbered con seculively. This Futurity is based upon the nomination of an animal by its owner, to be shown in the Futurity class at a designated show in the year she is of eligible age Four nominations (payments) are required for each animal that competes in the Futurity the initial nomina-tion as a call, a renomination as a year idd, and the final nominations as a system of the futurity of the source of data must be made on regulation entry blanks, accompanied by specified fees and postmarked by nomination dates and other rules ast forth below The accoundisted monies received from the four nominations shall make up the Purse for any one year and shall be divided as prize money among the subbitors according to the placings set forth below

ORGANIZATION This Futurity is sponsored and governed by the Maryland Hoistein Futurity Committee of the Maryland Hoistein Association

ELIGIBILITY . Any registered Holstein female born September, 1991 through August 31, 1992 is eligible for the 1995 Maryland Futurity Number 12

FEES

PURSE. Purses in this event shall consist of all monies received by the Association in connection therewith by way of nomination fees, subsequent payments, plus all other monies received from any person or persons or Fair Associations, sponsors of this show and etc, ex-cept the first payment which may be used for promotion of the Maryland Holstein Futurity if the Board of Direct ors so choose. All Futurity monies shall be kept in a separate Futurity fund and used only for Futurity pur noses

Should participation decline, the purse will include only those monies available for Futurity No. 12 based on per cent of existing schedule.

PRODUCTION AWARDS \$260 will be taken from the purse and divided among the top five wins shown in the year old fuurity class on the basis of their actual 305 day 2x 3 5% Fat Corrected Milk two year old milk pro

duction Only official DHIA or DHIR records will be con sidered and these records hust accompany the animal and be checked by the committee before the show The \$260 will be divided as inflows \$80 00 to the cow with highest actual 2 year old milk record, \$60 00 to second high \$50 00 to third high, \$40 to fourth high and \$30 to fifth high 2 year old milk record

The seller must in form the Buyer that the enimal purchased is stready en tered in the Futurity and it will be the responsibility of the Buyer to submit subsequent fees in accordance with rules and closing dates. nd closing dates


