Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was light to fair overall. Offerings ranged adequate to fully adequate. Live supplies were moderate. Weights varied in a full range. Slaughter schedules remained heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 54 to 62 cents. Trade sentiment was barely steady to steady. In the parts complex, wings and boneless/skinless breasts were available and slow in clearing. Bone-in breasts were irregularly balanced. Leg quarters and thighs were in best balance. Drums were fully adequate.

ATTN DODGE CITY OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY.

Compared to last week: Feeder steers and heifers over 600 lbs. steady; exception noted on 900-1000 lb. steers \$2.00 higher. Calves steady to \$2.00 higher with full advance on heifers. Calf demand good and much improved over past several weeks. Weather pattern is indicating good chances

for needed first rain since wheat planting. Calf condition similar to last Monday with many calves in attractive flesh condition versus the soft fleshy condition of previous period. Feedlot demand for yearlings moderate. Overall quality of calves and yearlings average to attractive. Weigh condition of both classes average to full. Yearlings continue average to thin in flesh and attractive to buyers. Slaughter cows \$1.00-\$2.00 lower. Slaughter bulls \$1.00-\$1.50 lower. Cow and bull demand fair from packers; good from country replacement buyers. Receipts this week 9,025; last week 12,138; last year 6,285. Supply consisted of 61% yearlings and big calves over 600 lbs.; 30% calves under 600 lbs.; 9% cows and bulls. Bulk prices follow; weighted average prices in parenthesis:
