A PRESIDENTIAL TIE

On November 7, 1876, the presidential election ended in an electoral tie between Democrat Samuel J. Tilden and Republican Rutherford B. Hayes. Tilden had a huge popular majority (250,000 more popular votes than Hayes), but he received only 184 electoral votes (one short of victory) and Hayes won 165 electoral votes. The decision went to the House of Representatives after some of the votes in the southern states had been challenged. After picking up all the 20 challenged votes the 54-year-old Hayes was declared a winner on March 3, 1877. It was said a deal was made between the Republicans and the Southern Democrats to end reconstruction in the South.

TIP OF THE WEEK

Make dish washing easier by soaking dishes with dried egg or milk in cold water instead of hot.

EARTHWISE

Many people feel guilty about using their dishwashers, but the good news is that a fully loaded automatic dishwasher uses less energy overall than washing the same amount of dishes by hand. Scrape the dishes to remove leftover food particles prior to loading, and turn off the machine before the heated drying cycle — the dishes will dry just fine without it and you'll avoid melting your plasticware. Most dishwashers now come with an "energy saver" setting that bypasses hot air drying altogether.

ELECTION CAKE

- 2 packages yeast
- 1 cup warm water
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1 1/2 cups sugar, divided
- 2 eggs
- 8 cups flour
- 1/2 pound raisins
- 1 cup milk



Mix yeast with water and 1/4 cup sugar. Cream 1 cup sugar with butter. Add eggs and yeast; blend well. Add 4 cups of flour; beat well. Mix raisins with remaining flour, add to batter. Add milk until dough is kneadable. Knead for 10 minutes. Divide dough in half and place in two greased loaf pans. Let rise for 3 to 4 hours. Bake at 350° F for 50 minutes.

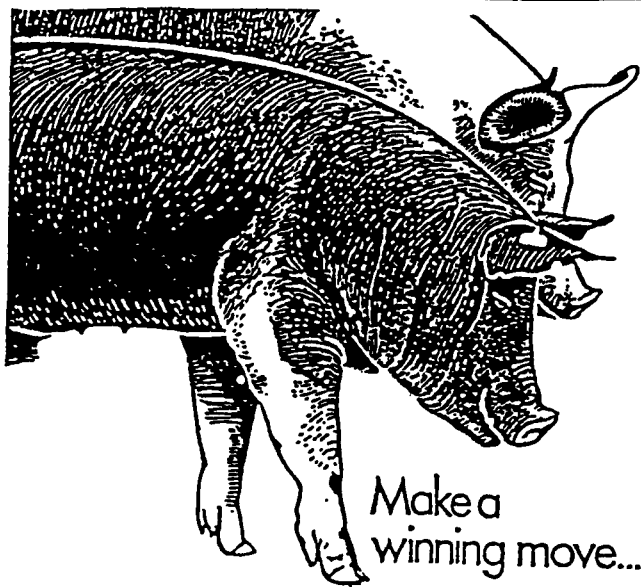
