

## Poultry Judging Team Heads For Nationals

COLLEGE PARK, Md. — With a recent second-place finish in regional competition, members of this year's Maryland 4-H poultry and egg judging team are gearing up for national competition on November 19 at Louisville, Ky.

The contest is a climax to the five-day National 4-H Poultry and Egg Conference that gets underway November 16 in conjunction with the North American International Livestock Exposition.

Team members are Chris Crum, 16, of New Midway (Frederick County); Kara Emory, 17, of Hughesville (Charles County); and two Queen Anne's County 15-year-olds: Charles Hood of Barclay and Kristina Reeser of Ingleside.

Maggie Boyden, 16, of Bel Alton (Charles County) will represent Maryland in the national 4-H egg preparation contest, also being held November 19 at

Louisville.

Team coach for the 12th consecutive year is Charles J. Wabeck of Salisbury, an extension poultry and food products specialist at the Lower Eastern Shore Research and Education Center near Princess Anne.

In regional competition on September 26 at Richmond, Va., this year's Maryland team placed second overall and first in both the egg quality and production hen categories.

Charles Hood was the high

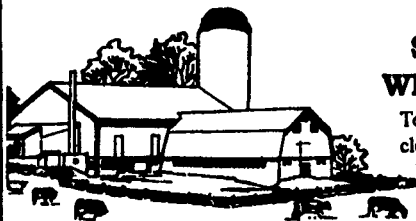
individual among all contestants in the egg quality class, while Kristina Reeser placed fourth. Charles was fifth in ready-to-cook poultry judging.
