THOMASVILLE (York Co.) - York County 4-H Lamb Club's treasury got a boost from regional restauranteur Bill Campbell, who purchased the champion lamb at the roundup sale, then donated the wooly winner back to the club.

Campbell, on behalf of his Hoss's Steak and Sea House restaurants, bought the 115-pound lamb from champion exhibitor Matt Trostle with a \$3.00 per pound price. Sent back through the ring for the second time to benefit the Lamb Club, the Hampshire market lamb brought a \$1.20 per pound bid from buyer Phil Sellers.

Reserve champion lamb, exhibited by Tabitha Ebersole, York, commanded a \$1.10 per pound bid. Winning bidder for the 115-pound lamb was Daryll Reedy, Reedy's Hampshires.

Bidding on the champion lightweight, the 85-pound project lamb of Kelly Myers, Thomasville, went to \$1.70 per pound, selling to Byron S. Waggoner, General Contractors.

Mike Olson's 100-pound mediumweight champion went under the gravel at an even one dollar bid, to buyer Creek View Acres, the Olson family.

Moorman Feed Company, represented by Jim Horton, took the bid on the reserve champion lightweight at \$1.35 per pound. Heather Bankert, Red Lion, exhibited the 80-pound, pink-ribbon winner.

The reserve champion mediumweight, shown by Glen Rock 4-H'er Lisa Dehoff, sold to a \$1.25 per pound bid. Buyer of the 100-pound lamb was Irvin Rappoldt.

A total of 49 market lambs sold in the club's final roundup sale of the season, averaging \$1.10 per pound with the champion price. Average without the champion was \$1.06.







The grand champion 4-H market lamb shown by Matt Trostle was sold to Bill Campbell, Hoss's Steak and Sea, and donated back to the club.



Gutter Grate




