The calf born September 1, 1992 is just the right age for showing. But Harold said while showing the calf is part of the deal, he wanted to give a calf that has a good pedigree


from a good cow family too. Brenna certainly has a good pedigree. Her dam has been milking more than 110 pounds for the first two months on test after making a 22,270m, 716f, 691p milk record as a five-year-old. The next two dams are high producing cows with good type and longevity. For those who keep track of these things, the deep pedigree lists the dam as a Rotate, out of a Pete, out of an Apollo, out of an Ivanhoe. How's that for a pedigree?

In addition, the calf's sire is To-Mar Black Star-ET, the top TPI Bull in the breed according to the July 1992 summary.

Youth awards to be presented at the banquet include recognition at the Black and White Show, the county distinguished junior member contest, and project forms recognition. Also awards will be presented for the member with the highest county milk, fat, and pro-
