Getz's cow with 826 pounds.

In the 4-year-old cow class, Timothy Getz's cow made 30,769 pounds of milk, while Justin Troutman's cow was second with 27,999 pounds, and Darin Nolt's was third was with 25,523 pounds.

For fat and protein production among 4-year-old cows, Timothy Getz's was also first — she made 1,036 pounds of fat and 879 pounds of protein.

Taking second in fat production was a cow owned by Darin Nolt which made 978 pounds. He also owned the third highest producer which made 915 pounds.

A cow owned by Stephanie Wagner made the second most protein among the 4-year-olds with 833 pounds, followed with a third place production of 832 pounds by a cow owned by Justin Troutman.

Among the aged cow class, a Holstein owned by Jeremy Troutman made the most milk with 28,803 pounds, followed by a cow owned by Todd Getz, which made 27,184 pounds. Third place was taken by a cow owned by Duane Nolt which made 25,957 pounds of

In fat production, a cow owned by Daune Nolt was first with 1,202 pounds, followed by 1,185 pounds made by a cow owned by Todd Getz. A cow owned by Jeremy Troutman was third with 1,016 pounds of fat.

In protein production among aged cows, a cow owned by Jeremy Troutman was first with 881 pounds of protein. Second place was made by a cow owned by Chris Wagner, with 858 pounds protein. Third place was captured by a cow owned by Duane Nolt, with 841 pounds.
