USDA DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN SUMMARY GRAIN AND SOYBEAN PRICES CLOSED MIXED, TUESDAY. WHEAT MIXED, FROM 1 TO 4 CENTS HIGHER TO UNCHANGED TO 3 CENTS LOWER. CORN MIXED. SORGHUM SORGHUM UNCHANGED TO 2 CENTS HIGHER. SOYBEANS 2 TO 6 CENTS HIGHER. WHEAT PRICES MOSTLY HIGHER ON EXCELLENT EXPORT DEMAND, ESPECIALLY FROM FORMER USSR. CHINA IS REPORTED SEEKING TO BUY U.S. WHEAT. CORN PRICES MIXED WITH SUPPORT STEMMING FROM HIGHER THAN EXPECTED EXPORT INSPECTION FIGURE YESTERDAY HARVEST PROGRESS REPORTED A LITTLE HIGHER THAN EXPECTED DESPITE CONTINUED DELAYS IN MANY AREAS. HIGHER BEAN PRICES DUE TO CONTINUED CONCERNS ABOUT E.C. OILSEED AGREEMENT AND LACK OF EXPORT DEMAND.
