MMI is a 6,000 member dairy farmer owned cooperative encompassing an eight state Midwestern area including Ohio, Indiana, Pennsylvania, Michigan, New York, Kentucky, Maryland and West Virginia. Last year MMI marketed more than 3.9 billion pounds or 453 million gallons of milk.

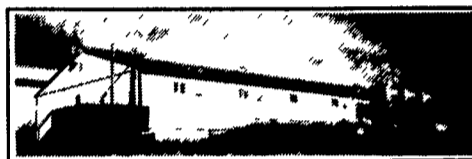

Dosage: Vaccination of healthy cattle is recommended. Aseptically rehydrate the freeze-dried bacterin-toxoid with the accompanying adjuvant-containing sterile diluent and administer 2 mL intramuscularly or subcutaneously. Healthy cattle should be vaccinated a minimum of 10 days prior to weaning, shipping, or exposure to stress or infectious conditions. Primary vaccination. A single dose should be administered to healthy cattle. Although only a single dose is necessary to confer active immunity, a booster dose is recommended whenever subsequent stress or exposure is likely.
