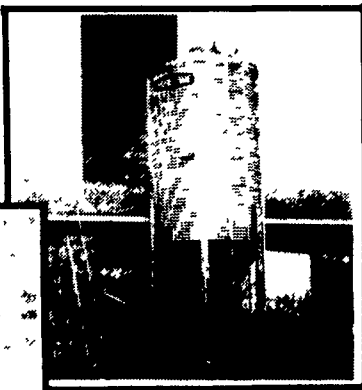

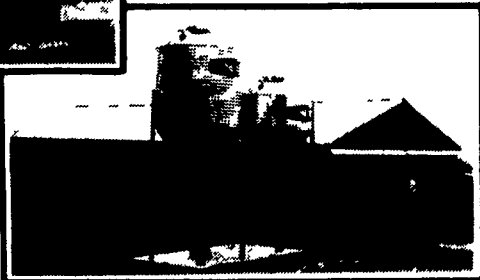

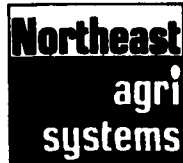

Corn Classic To Feature Range Of Programs

ST. LOUIS, Mo. — Bits and bytes of computer help, health screening, and estate planning are three of the topics corn growers may learn more about during informal question and answer sessions at the 1993 Corn Classic.

The National Corn Growers Association's (NCGA) 35th anniversary Corn Classic takes place February 21-23 in San Antonio, Texas. More than 2,500 attendees are expected.

"Health Screening" features health tests including hearing, cholesterol, and blood pressure readings. "Pesticide Handling Systems; What's Down the Row?" explores the potential of new technology in a lively "show and tell" format.

"Estate Planning" with Merrill Lynch demystifies the complex decisions needed to protect an estate's future. "Educating Tomorrow's Consumers" uses computer modules to introduce a variety of programs for classrooms. It features Shirley Traxler, USDA director of Ag in the Classroom.

"New News In Corn Utilization" provides an upbeat look at futuristic products to increase the profit potential on the farm. And a "Made in America, Cotton Fashion Show" displays the most popular fashions made of cotton. It is hosted by the national Cotton Council of America's Cotton Queen.

Rounding out the hands-on sessions is "Bits and Bytes of Computer Help," which keys in on ways to upgrade management skills and includes demonstrations of software and on-line services. And "Federal Crop Insurance" delves into program details with a panel of industry experts, including a representative of American Agrisure and an ag economist from Kansas State University.

In addition to its educational program, Corn Classic features an extensive trade show, entertainers Crystal Gayle and Lionel Cartwright, and the opportunity to help shape the future of the corn industry.
