## Wayne DHIA Holds Meeting

HONESDALE (Wayne Co.) — The Wayne County affiliate of the Pennsylvania Dairy Herd Improvement Association (Pa.DHIA) completed its 66th year on Nov. 17 with its annual meeting and dinner at Lukan's Farm Resort, near Hawley.

A total of 88 herds completed a full year of testing. The average production per cow was 17,293 pounds of milk and 638 pounds of butterfat. Income over feed costs, per cow, was \$1,316.

· High Cow for Protein Production - Kevin Burleigh, Pleasant Mount, "Cheryl", 959 pounds of protein.

• High Lifetime Cow for Milk Production - Kevin Burleigh, Pleasant Mount, "Syrup", 12 lactations, 248,685 pounds of milk. • High Lifetime Cow for Butter-

fat Production - Jericho Dairy, Lake Como, "Liza", 11 lactations, 9,974 pounds of butterfat.

· High Lifetime Cow for Protein Production - Rowe Brothers, Honesdale, "Dana", 8 lactations, 6,633 pounds of protein.

· High Quality Milk Award -James Slocum, Susquehanna, 64,000 Somatic Cell Count.


