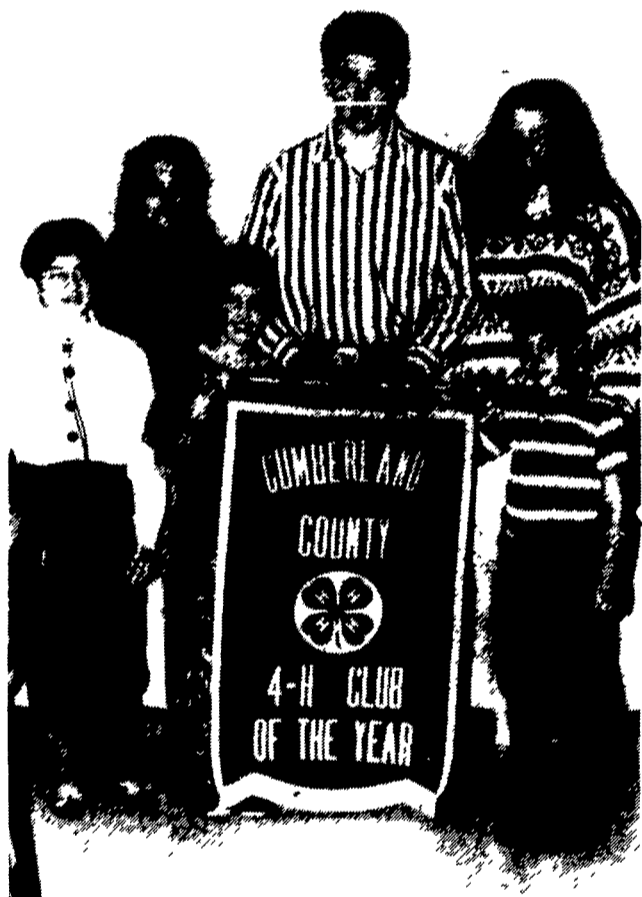
4-H Public Speaking Winners Named

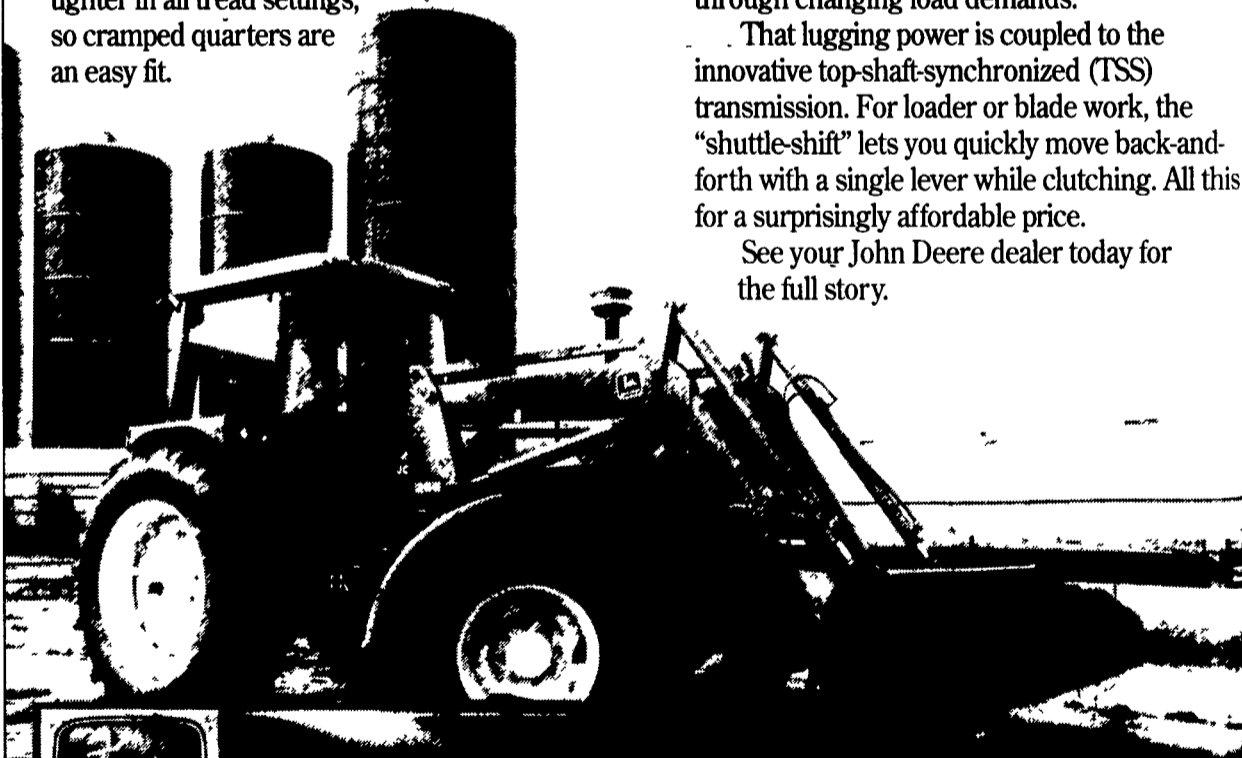
