# Protect Trees By Attending Workshop

WILKES-BARRE (Luzerne Co.) - Each year we lose half a million acres of forested land in the United States, not to timber harvesting, but instead to suburban sprawl. The exact features that often draw people toward a home nestled in the woods are being destroyed during the building

Trees are valuable assets to commercial and residential property, contributing up to 25 percent of the retail value, and have been ranked sixth by realtors as an influencing factor in property sales. During construction, damage to trees often causes tree decline and death, only to be followed by expensive removal

On January 20, Penn State Cooperative Extension in cooperation with the PA Urban and Community Forestry Council, Bureau of Forestry, Conservation Districts, Pennsylvania Environmental Council, and the Pocono NE -RC&D Forestry Committee will hold a seminar for members of the construction industry, community officials and planners, and natural resource professionals, titled "Building With Nature: Protecting Trees during Construction to Enhance Development Value and Salability."

Topics will include creative site

design and planning, the damaging effects of construction, low impact techniques used to protect trees, and a panel discussion with representatives of various professions.

The workshop will be held at Capri's Restaurant on Lake Wallenpaupack. The workshop registration fee is \$25 per person, which includes lunch and handout materials. Pre-registration is required before January 13.
