A trustee of Gettysburg College and former chairman of the college's Board of Fellows, Shaw is also a member of the Board of Ad-

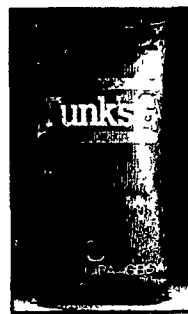

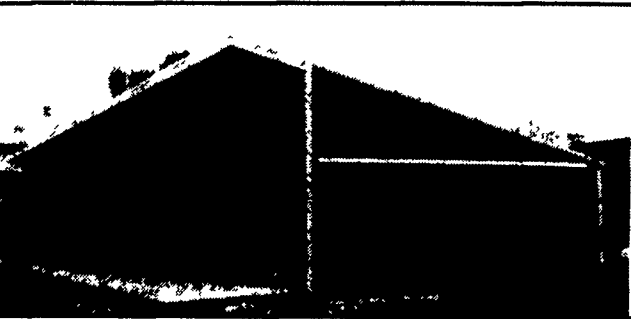

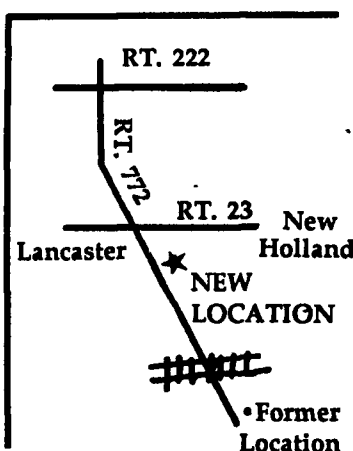
