 event. Four teams from Pennsylvania FFA chapters competed in three separate events: hay bale stacking, "cow pie" dodging, and "milk robotics" (milk pouring). The "cow pie" dodging consisted of team members traveling through an area covered with "cow pies" made of chocolate pudding.
 Gifford Pinchot FFA, from Dillsburg, York County, came away with the top prize, \$75, in this contest. Team members Quentin Crone, Trish Erford and Dave Myers had the highest score in the event. Scores for the teams

were based upon time and several quality standards. A team from Greenwood FFA, Millerstown, Perry County, came in second, winning a \$50 prize.

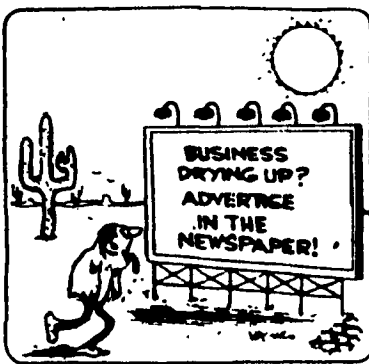
Two other teams competed, one from Albion FFA, Erie County, and the other from Moniteau FFA, Butler County.
