or to develop livestock feed cost data, here's this week's average costs of various ingredients as compiled from regional reports across the state of Pennsylvania. Remember these are averages so you will need to adjust your figures up or down according to your location and the quality of your crop.

- Corn, No. 2y - 2.34 BU. 4.19 CWT.
- Wheat, No. 2 - 3.43 BU. 5.72 CWT.
- Barley, No. 3 - 1.73 BU. 3.69 CWT.
- Oats, No. 2 - 1.54 BU. 4.80 CWT.
- Soybeans, No. 1 - 5.38 BU. 8.99 CWT.
- Ear Corn - 56.50 TON 2.83 CWT.
- Alfalfa Hay - 111.25 TON 5.56 CWT.
- Mixed Hay - 105.00 TON 5.25 CWT.
- Timothy Hay - 103.75 TON 5.19 CWT.


RESURFACING NO PEEL BARN PAINTER
