

Cattle Feeder's Day Set

LANCASTER (Lancaster Co.)—The Lancaster County Cattle Feeder's Day is scheduled for Tuesday, February 2, at the Farm and Home Center in Lancaster. The theme for this year's event is "Moving Ahead In The Cattle Industry."

Featured speaker this year will be Dr. Gary Smith, professor of animal science at Colorado State University, who holds the prestigious Monfort Endowed Chair in Meat Science. Prior to joining the Colorado State faculty in 1990, he was head of the Department of Animal Science at Texas A&M University for eight years.

Smith's professional member-

ships include the American Meat Science Association, American Society of Animal Science, and Institute of Food Technologists. His research interests include food safety; carcass evaluation and grading; composition quality, and palatability attributes of carcasses and wholesale cuts; and transportation packaging and distribution of fresh meat. He has received more than 20 awards and honors, including The American Society of Animal Science Meat Science Research Award in 1974, American Meat Science Association Distinguished Teaching Award in 1974, American Meat Science Association Signal Service Award

in 1991, and the Headliner Award from the Livestock Publications Council in 1992.

Smith will present two topics addressing "The 1991 NCA Beef Quality Audit" and "Perception vs. Reality — Beef Safety."

Robert Anderson, Penn State extension agronomist in Lancaster County, will present "Mixing Site Safety," a topic eligible for pesticide license credits. The agronomist will also explain "Chemsweep," a statewide effort to dis-

pose of unwanted stored pesticides.

H. Louis Moore, Penn State extension economist, will again provide economic insight with "Outlook For Cattle Feeders."

Addressing the important issue of feedlot ventilation will be Penn State Extension Agricultural Engineer Dan McFarland, and an update on implementing will be provided to help improve beef quality assurance efforts.

No reservations are necessary.

Lunch tickets may be purchased at the door until 11:30 a.m.

In addition to the formal program, there will be an opportunity to inspect commercial exhibits and visit other cattlemen. The event will begin at 8:30 a.m. with exhibit visitation and the program starts promptly at 9:30 a.m.

The meeting, conducted by the Penn State Cooperative Extension, concludes at 3 p.m. with a question and answer session.


nice farm, they work hard at it. They gave me a whole different outlook on farming." So when his time was up in the service, he returned to Tioga County to join his dad in the family business.

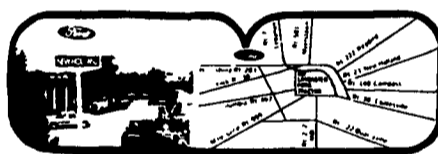
