anuary 27 is the birthday of Charles Lutwidge Dodgson, English mathematician, logician, and Oxford professor Although his scholarly works are largely forgotten, he is well-remembered as Lewis Carroll, the author of Alice's Adventures in Wonderland and Through the Looking-Glass Dodgson hand wrote and illustrated the first manuscript and presented it as a gift to Alice Liddell, daughter of an Oxford dean The story was later revised and expanded for publica-

tion Dodgson's friendship with Alice and in particular, a trip upriver from Oxford to Godstow with Alice and her sisters, provided the inspiration for the story
