

Farm Winter Meeting Set

FOREST HILL, Md. — The 1993 Mid-Winter Educational Meeting for Harford County has been scheduled for Tuesday, February 16 beginning at 8:30 a.m.

The farm meeting will be held at McComas Hall of the Bel Air United Methodist Church in Bel Air, Md.

The focus of the morning session will be crop management. Highlighting these sessions will be Dr. Arv Grybauskas, speaking on grey leaf spot disease and Dr. Ron Ritter with pesticide updates and new products. To round out this session, pesticide facilities will be discussed by Mr. Herb

Brodie, ag engineer, Wye Research and Education Center.

This meeting is slated as a qualifying meeting for private applicator recertification, and will offer discussions on pesticide regulations/updates and worker safety information by Mary Ellen Setting of MDA.

The "New Harford County Rural Plan" is the topic of discussion for the afternoon session. An open discussion led by representatives from the Office of Planning and Zoning along with community and agricultural leaders will be presented. This session will be an excellent opportunity for you to hear and be heard on this major county legislation.

The morning-afternoon session will include all day exhibits by local agribusinesses and will include a \$5 lunch. Preregistration

is not required.

Commodity Marketing is the emphasis of the evening (6:30 p.m.) dinner session. Dr. Jim Russell, marketing specialist, will lead the workshop-type discussions. This evening meal is planned with family in mind, so bring the entire family for this strategy session. Dinner will cost \$10/person and preregistration is required.
