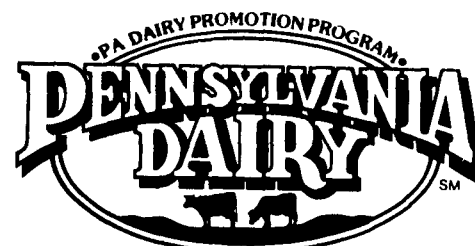
KANAGY SALE

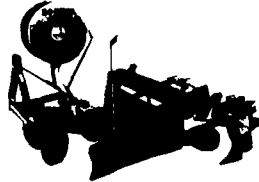

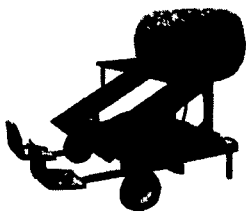

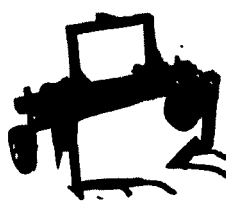
FLAT BED MODEL 560 PLASTIC LAYER
