## Cost Sharing Available For Animal Groups To Meet Lancaster Farming, Saturday, February 6, 1993-A25 **For Educational Program** Management Integrated

SMOKETOWN (Lancaster Co.) - The Lancaster County ASCS office has announced a signup period for farmers interested in receiving cost sharing for intewater quality practices.

The cost sharing is part of the Water Quality Incentive Program(WQIP). To be eligible for the cost sharing, farmers must live in the Pequea or Mill Creek watersheds in Lancaster County.

Farmers will receive \$7/per acre to offset the cost of hiring an approved crop consultant to soil test, regularly scout for insects, weeds, and other crop pests. Consultants will use this information to make fertilizer and pesticide management recommendations.

The sign-up period will be open grated crop management and other from Feb. 22 until March 12, Farmers will need to visit the ASCS office in the Farm and Home Center during that time period to sign


HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) - A statewide conference for animal users will be held on February 12 here at the Days Inn Airport.
