Feeder heifers and heifer calves \$2.00-\$3.00 lower. Trade was active after a cautious opening. Demand moderate early but turned good by noon Monday with notable improvement in market. Positive reaction by CME to Friday's COF report helped stabilize feeder cattle market. Quality of supply was plain thru attractive. Weigh-ups gaunt to average, few full late. Flesh condition generally attractive to buyers; most feeder cattle in average to slightly thin condition; calves in average to moderately thin flesh. Slaughter cows and bulls steady. Cow and bull

demand good. Receipts this week 10,450; last week 11,179; last year 9,691. Supply consisted of 62 percent feeders over 600 lbs.; 31 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 7 percent cows and bulls.
