The interactive telecasts, sponsored by the United Soybean Board (USB), will address issues

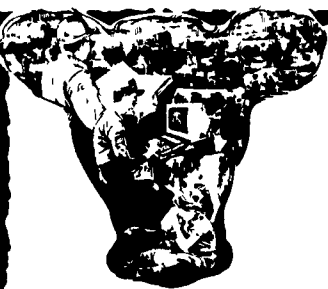
related to the National Soybean Checkoff and allow producers in 28 states to question USB members about the checkoff.

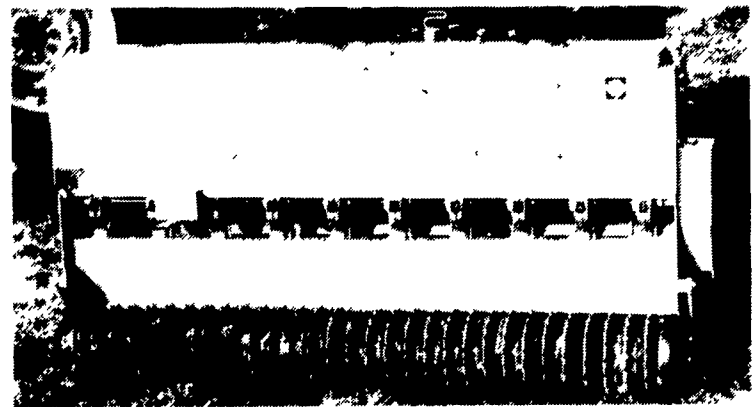

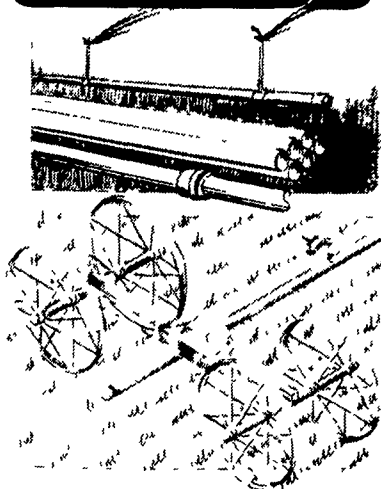
