The extension strives to continue to meet the many needs of the community despite the funding cutbacks of the government. Dr. Charles Krueger, Penn State associate dean, said that the university ranks 11th nationally as a major research center with the College of Agriculture attributed to one-fifth of the research.

While the extension is implementing the government's recommendations to use fewer staff and faculty, Krueger expressed concern that the cutbacks could effect the research and services needed by the ag community.

The force behind the services of the extension is the extension agents said Michelle Rodgers, regional extension director. In recog-

nition of their work, Leon Ressler received a five-year award and Chet Hughes a 10-year award.

Ressler also received special recognition from the Chesapeake Bay Foundation. Lamonte Garber told of Ressler's work in organizing a series of field trips for farmers and agents to travel to the bay and see how water quality is being affected by pollution. The Bay

Foundation helps provide funding for more than 35,000 persons to sail on the bay to examine the water.

"We believe it is important for people to experience the bay first hand," Garber said.

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which the milk is produced and the health of the herd producing the milk is also involved.

"There are those who think that if their bacteria counts are below the limits, nothing else matters. Bacteria counts are an indicator of the quality of milk being produced, but only milk from two different pickups is being tested each month. The ideal way would be to test each pickup, but that is not economical-ly feasible.

"When a rating is lost, every member of the cooperative loses.
