

ATTN: DODGE CITY OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY: Compared to last week: Feeder steers over 600 lbs. \$1.00-\$2.00 higher; stocker steers and steer calves \$2.00-\$4.00 higher. Feeder heifers and heifer calves steady to \$1.00 higher. Trade active with very good demand for steers; moderate demand for heifers. Quality of supply average thru attractive. Conditions also attractive to buyers with bulk of feeders and stockers in average thru moderately thin flesh and largely average to gaunt weigh conditions. Slaughter cows fully \$1.00 higher, slaughter bulls steady. Cow and bull demand good. Receipts this week 6,400; last week 10,447; last year 9,707. Supply consisted of 67 percent feeders over 600 lbs.; 27 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 6 percent cows and bulls. Bulk price ranges follow. Weighted averages in


