higher.

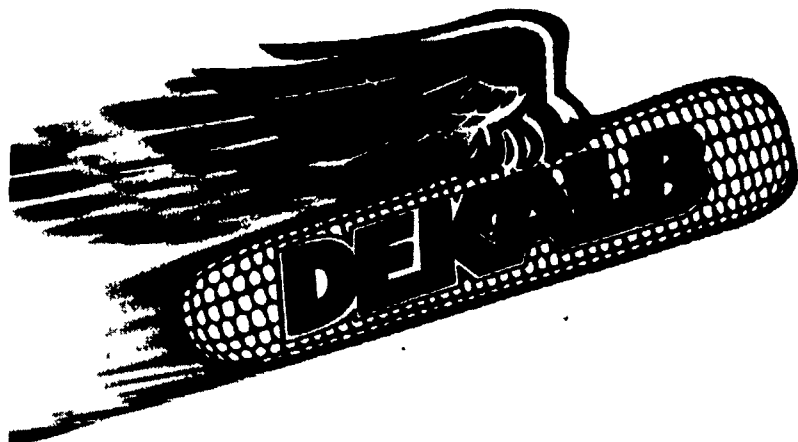
If you sell the cow with mastitis for \$600 and purchase a replacement for \$1,600, the \$1,000 cost should be spread out over several years because that cow will make replacements.

"A cow is a capital investment," he said.

Although culling a sick cow may cause a large, one-time expense, the benefits accrue over a longer period of time, and may be less expensive than treating her, he said.
