

Two-Cylinder Club Holds Banquet

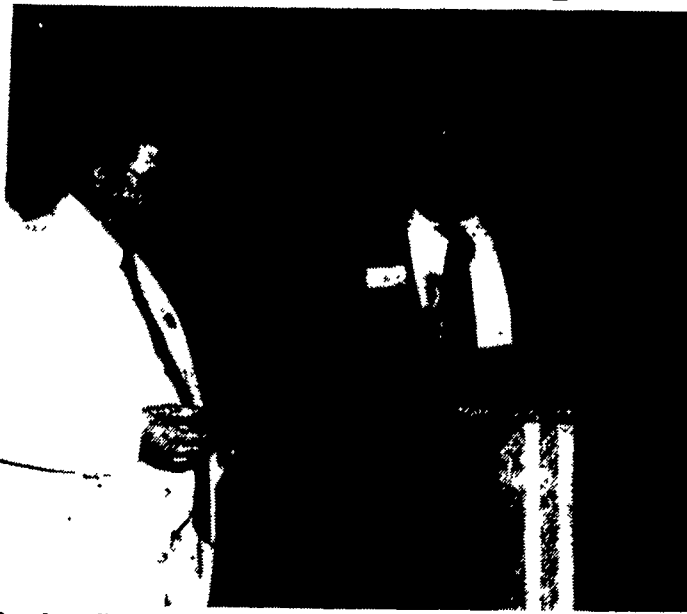

Engle To New Zealand

UNIVERSITY PARK (Centre Co.) — Clair Engle, associate professor of animal science, will be spending the first six months of 1993 on sabbatical in New Zealand learning about agriculture technology transfer.

Engle will study firsthand how the technology transfer system at Massey University, Palmerston North, might be implemented into agriculture extension education programs here in Pennsylvania.

Technology transfer, simply stated, means moving new ideas from laboratories to farm practices. According to Engle, "Its success depends on a partnership of farmers and faculty who are committed to planning and implementing new programs for improving a farmer's profitability and environmental practices."

An industry user group concept for agriculture technology transfer was initiated in New Zealand in the early 1980s. The adoption and success of this educational process

has received recent international attention for its positive impact within the New Zealand livestock and dairy industries during the last 10 years. It is also evidenced by renewed enthusiasm in livestock farming and increased interest in applying new technology in regions where the user group concept has lasted for three or more years.






