OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY Compared to last Thursday's advance: Feeder steers over 650 lbs. steady to \$1.60 lower. Stocker steers and steer calves to 700 lbs. steady. Feeder heifers steady; heifers under 550 lbs. regained Thursday's loss and sold \$1.00-\$3.00 higher. Demand good for calves and stockers. Demand moderate for feeder cattle. Quality of cattle and all conditions attractive to buyers inducing top prices per cwt. Quality attractive to average. Feeder cattle in slightly thin to moderately fleshy wheat condition. Stocker flesh moderately thin to average. Weigh-ups gaunt to average. Due to poor wheat pastures cattle are coming off considerable lighter than this time last year. Over 800 lb. cattle comprised 28% of Monday's supply compared to 43% same period last year. Slaughter cows \$3.00-\$5.00 lower. Slaughter bulls \$1.00-\$2.00 lower. Cow and bull demand moderate. Sharp declines reflect the steep downturns of the dressed product last week. Receipts this week 21,750; last week 10,861; last year 15,175. Run consisted of 77% feeders over 600 lbs.; 20% calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs.; 3% cows and bulls. Bulk price ranges follow. Weighted averages in parenthesis.

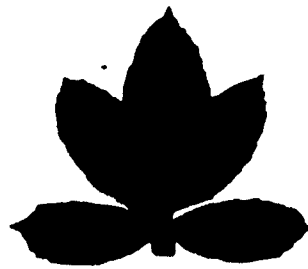
