

Baby Born On National Agriculture Day Receives Pennsylvania Commodities

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — Adam Herrold, the newborn son of Troy and Cathy Herrold of Lower Paxton Township, was recently honored as Harrisburg's Agriculture Day Baby. The Herrold family received two baskets of Pennsylvania food products from Agriculture Secretary Boyd E. Wolff.

Wolff honored the Herrold family as part of Pennsylvania's celebration of National Agriculture Week in the Harrisburg area. National Agriculture Week coincides with the beginning of spring and honors America's farmers who will be preparing their fields for planting.

"We're honoring the first baby born on Agriculture Day 1993 to symbolize the importance of agriculture and farming to our chil-

dren and to future generations," Wolff said.

"Pennsylvania's farmers and agribusinesses contribute a great deal to the high quality of life in the Keystone State."

The Agriculture Baby contest involved the four greater Harrisburg area hospitals, and the title was awarded to the first baby to arrive on Pennsylvania's Agriculture Day, March 18. Adam Herrold arrived at Harrisburg Hospital at 1:42 a.m.

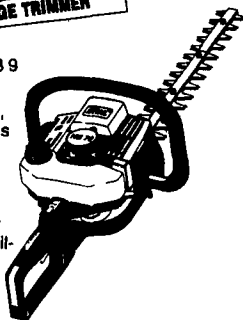

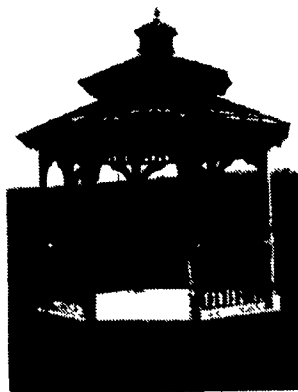
