Prices for larger sizes trended higher at some points in the midwest; otherwise, prices were unchanged. The trade sentiment was steady to firm, mostly steady to fully steady. Demand for canted eggs ranged light to good, mostly fair; however, the trade anticipates improved demand going into next week in preparation for the upcoming holiday. Supplies of larger sizes were in good balance and held with confidence, mediums were at least adequate and additional supplies were difficult to place. In the central states, breaking stock prices were unchanged. Trading and demand were irregular. Breakers were cautious. Supplies were adequate. The trade senti-

ment was steady. Prices for light type fowl in the southeast trended lower. Offers increased. The undertone was barely steady to weak.
