"I started milking cows in March of 1992. The herd I bought was being fed a TMR, mineral program. The RHA was 21,000, so I was hoping to keep close to that by individually feeding the cows. At first, the biggest difference was that my butterfat dropped from 3.6 to 3.4, but surprisingly the milk held pretty good. Some mid-lactation cows even picked up.
