High protein cow was Ro-Meyer Settler Holly, owned by Steve Meyers of Campbell Run Jerseys, Franklin County. Holly produced 22,639 pounds of milk with 919

pounds of protein for a 4.1 percent protein test at four years and four months.

Pennsylvania High Herd Awards went to:

• 10-30 cow herd for milk, fat and protein — Ralph and Gary Oakes, 17,254 pounds of milk, 686 pounds of protein and 839 pounds of fat.

• 31-60 cow herd for milk and protein — Spruce Row, 17,456 pounds of milk, 637 pounds of

protein.

• 31-60 cow herd for fat — Ironwood Dairy, 818 pounds of fat.

• 60-100 cow herd for milk, fat and protein — Calvin Watson, 16,397 pounds of milk, 630 pounds of protein and 815 pounds of fat.

• 100 cow herd and over for milk, fat and protein — Van De Jerseys, 16,833 pounds of milk, 621 pounds of protein and 850 pounds of fat.

SRBC To Serve As Analysis Sponsor

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — the Susquehanna River Basin Commission announced recently that it will serve as the non-federal sponsor for an analysis of the feasibility to regionalize small water supply systems in Lebanon County.

This analysis is to be performed by the Baltimore District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, under the authority of the Planning Assistance to States (Sect. 22) Program of the Water Resources Development Act of 1974.

SRBC sponsorship is

contingent upon the availability of non-federal matching funds from the state.

As a result of the Baltimore District's 1992 Harrisburg Metropolitan Area Regional Water Supply Study — for which SRBC also served as non-federal sponsor — the Capital Region Water Board urged the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Resources to request the assistance of the Army Corps to investigate the options available which would lead to a regionalization of small systems within the original study area.

The year-long \$100,000 study is to identify and evaluate a range of regionalization alternatives to meet the future water supply need for two groups of small water suppliers in Lebanon County.

A distribution network will be designed to interconnect all systems within each group in order to facilitate regionalization of sources and treatment facilities.

Interconnections with existing large neighboring water supply systems will also be considered.

Selected alternatives are to be developed in sufficient detail to define an estimated cost and to make judgements on potential impacts and implementability.

This is to be a "reconnaissance"-level study, according to the SRBC, and is to depend on information from existing sources.

The development of detailed specifications for water supply facilities and distribution systems will not be addressed.

However, capacities, sizes, and general types of facilities are to be described for production, treatment, storage and distribution facilities.

The study areas are defined as the portions of Lebanon County which are served by the following water supply systems: Sycamore Hill Mobile Home Park, Stony Crest Estates Water Co-op, Cornwall Municipal Water Company, Mollies Spring Water, Gretna Springs, Mt. Gretna Authority, Mt. Gretna Heights Water Supply, Quentin Water Company, Fredericksburg Water Authority, Sunrise Trailer Court, Lebanon Valley Mobile Home Park, Big Boulder Mobile Home Park, Long's Mobile Home Park, and Countryside Mobile Home Park.

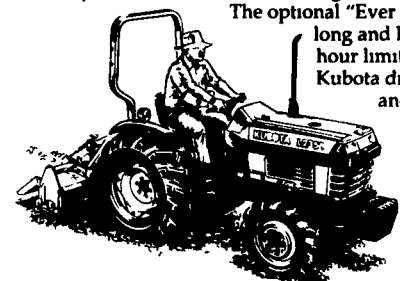
