OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY: Compared to last week: Feeder steers and few heifers over 700 lbs. \$1.00-\$2.00 lower. Stocker steers steady; stocker heifers \$2.00-\$4.00 higher. Demand good for all steers and feeder heifers; excellent demand for stocker heifers. Genetic quality average, few attractive sets. Flesh increasing on feeders and this a minor detriment to price per cwt from last week; feeders in average to moderately fleshy condition. Stocker flesh more attractive, average to very thin. Weigh-ups comparable to last week mostly average to moderately full, with exception of stockers gaunt to average. Wheat pastures looking very good these past few weeks. Bulk sales slaughter cows and bulls steady with few closing sales on Wednesday \$5.50-\$1.50 higher. Demand good for slaughter cows and bulls. Receipts this week 6,925; last week 9,933; last year 13,077. Supply consisted of 79% feeders over 600 lbs.; 19% calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs.; 2% cows and bulls. Bulk price ranges follow with weighted averages in parenthesis.
