OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY

Compared to last week: Stocker and feeder steers over 600 lbs. \$1.00-\$2.00 higher. Heifers steady, exception noted on those over 700 lbs. steady to \$1.00 higher. Demand good with active trading. Quality plain thru attractive. Feeder cattle in slightly fleshy thru moderately fleshy condition. Stockers thin to average flesh, however several sets bawling calves in supply. Weigh-ups gaunt to average. Slaughter cows steady to \$1.00 higher than last week's close or \$1.50 higher than bulk sales last Tuesday. Slaughter bulls steady. Demand very good for cows, moderate for bulls. Receipts this week 7,825; last week 6,939; last year 12,698. Supply consisted of 79% feeders and stockers over 600 lbs.; 17% calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs.; 4% cows and bulls. Bulk price ranges follow with weighted averages in parenthesis.

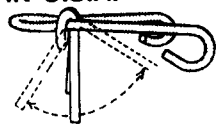

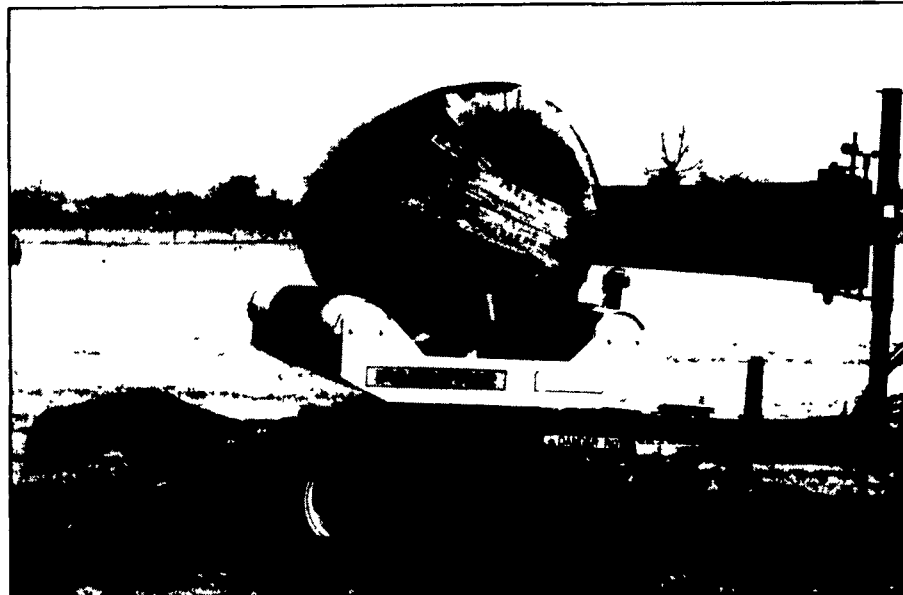
