Priedrich Froebel was born on April 21, 1782. At a time when most people believed in imposing adult standards on children. Froebel saw the need for nurturing their emotional and spiritual nature. He believed in leading children to self understanding through play greater freedom and group activities. Froebel opened his first school in Germany in 1837 He coined the term kindergarten to convey an environ ment where children grew freely like plants tended in a garden Froebel's education plan gained widespread

acceptance throughout Europe. In 1868 the first Finglish speaking kindergarten was opened in - Boston The first public kindergarten was opened in St. Louis. Missouri. in 1873


