Lighter weight stockers and calves fully steady, with exception of stocker heifers \$2.00 higher in very active trading. Demand good for all classes. Early feeder trade moderately active, turning active late; stocker trade continues very active thruout. Quality of supply mostly average, few attractive. Feeder cattle conditions considerably less attractive to buyers than last week. Feeder cattle in average to fleshy wheat condition. Feeder cattle in average to full weigh condition. Stocker condition very attractive with most in slightly thin to very thin flesh. Stocker weigh-ups gaunt to full. Slaughter cows steady to \$1.00 higher with good demand. Slaughter bulls steady under moderate demand. Receipts this week 8,900; last week 7,805; last year 7,149. 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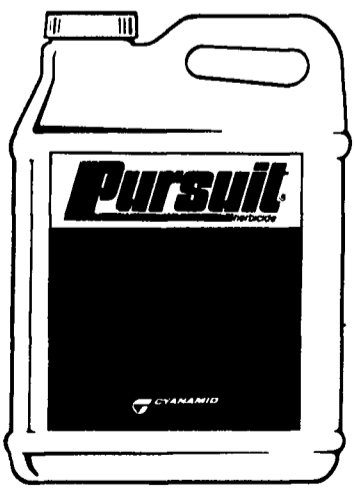
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
