Light supply of stocker steers under 600 lbs. and all stocker heifers \$2.00-\$3.00 lower. Demand good. Trade active. Quality of feeder cattle average through attractive. Bulk offerings 575-950 lb. steers and 525-775 lb. heifers with majority in slightly thin to moderately fleshy wheat condition. Weigh-ups highly varied but generally average. Light stockers and calves not as attractive as past two months. The thin to very thin stockers that this area has sold since March were not readily available. Slaughter cows and bulls steady under moderate demand. Receipts this week 8,975; last week 12,209; last year 15,215. Supply consisted of 83% feeders and stockers over 600 lbs.; 11% calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs.; 6% cows and bulls. Bulk price ranges follow with weighted averages in parenthesis.


