Trustees meeting on Thursday, two well-known agricultural leaders seek election: David Morrow, DVM, PHD, from State College, and Gordon Hiller, state Grange master from Williamsport.

Morrow currently serves on the board as vice-chairman of the physical plant committee and as a member of the educational policy committee. He previously served as vice chairman of the Hershey Medical Center committee and member of the finance committee.

ture Conservation Coalition. Hiller is a certified professional





Representatives from Pennsylvania agricultural societies will elect two members to the Penn State Board of Trustees on May 13 at University Park at their regular board meeting.


