**OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY:** Compared To Last Week: Feeder steers steady to \$1.00 higher; feeder heifers steady. Stocker steers steady to \$2.00 higher during Monday's active trade, closed steady. Stocker heifers steady thru-out. Feeder cattle flesh continues thinner than typically seen on May wheat cattle and this attractive to buyers. Weigh-ups continue average. Weather pattern continues to be very beneficial to pastures. Summer grazing should be equivalent to last years excellent season. Receipts this week 17,100; last week 7,564; last year 15,233. Supply consisted of 89% feeders and stockers over 600 lbs.; 8% calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs.; 3% cows and bulls. Bulk price ranges follow with weighted averages in parenthesis.

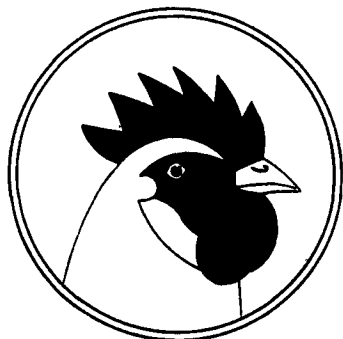
