OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY: Compared To Last Week: Feeder steers and heifers fully steady. Stocker steers \$2.00-\$3.00 lower; light supply stocker heifers steady. Demand good with active trading. Quality and conditions somewhat less attractive to buyers than last week. Quality of supply plain thru attractive. Flesh condition of feeders highly varied from slightly thin thru fleshy. Weigh conditions average to full, end gaunt. Bulk receipts steers and heifers over

600 lbs. off wheat. Weather clear and in 80's this week. Receipts this week 14,900; last week 17,304; last year's holiday shortened run 3,426. Supply consisted of 88% feeders and stockers over 600 lbs.; 9% calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs.; 3% cows and bulls. Bulk price ranges follow with weighted averages in parenthesis.

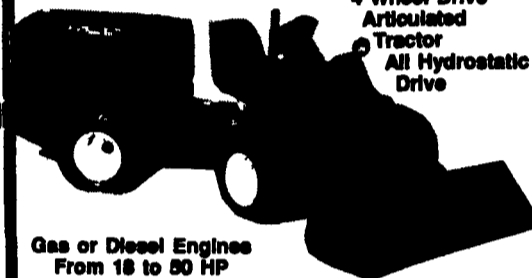

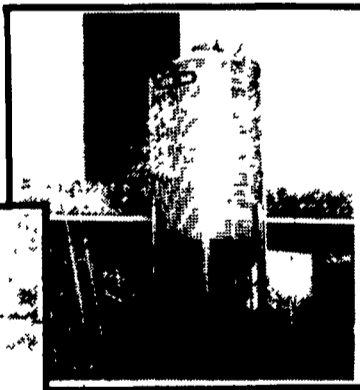

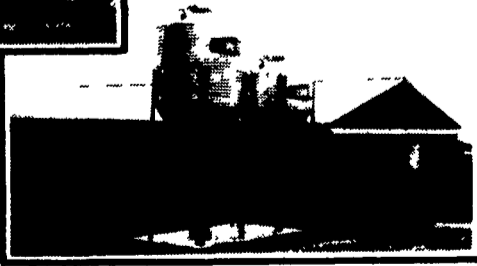
