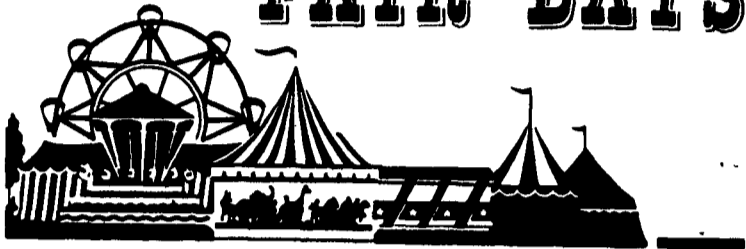

TIOGA COUNTY FAIR

Agriculture is still the number one industry in Tioga County and there is no better place to see it all than at the 1993 Tioga County Fair, held at the Fairgrounds in Whitneyville from Tuesday, August 10 through Sunday, August 15.

On opening day, visitors can view the fresh flowers, vegetables, wool exhibit, hay and grain, and all types of youth exhibits — all grown in Tioga County. There will also be antique tractors displayed on the grounds all week long.

On Tuesday evening, visitors will have the opportunity to join in

the fun of the annual baked goods auction. The 1993 Fair Queen will be crowned by Teresa McIlwain, 1992 Fair Queen. Visitors can take in the horse pull or experience the amazing piano talent of John Bressler.

Wednesday starts a round of dairy and livestock shows that will last throughout the rest of the week with the 4-H and vocational dairy show. Wednesday is Family Day. There will be clowns, an ice cream eating contest, a kiddie tractor pull, and special prices on amusement rides.

On Thursday there is an early morning showing of the county's best beef animals. Lots of fun can

be had in the afternoon viewing the junior sheep blocking contest in which sheep will be brought straight from the field to be fitted. This contest will be followed by the open and junior sheep show. In the Youth Center Building, there will be an all-day sheep and wool demonstration in which a sheep will be shorn, and wool will be spun and woven into a shawl which will be auctioned off at the Junior Livestock Sale. At 6:30 p.m. there will be a dog obedience demonstration in the horse ring.

On Friday, the Swine Show precedes the Open Colored Breed Show. And for those who like crafts, there is a craft show in the Youth Center Building where an entire quilt will be made during the day.

Saturday continues with a horse show and the open Holstein Dairy Show. Saturday afternoon at the Junior Livestock Sale the prize-winning meat animals will be auctioned off as well as baskets of milk products and a gallon of milk from the grand champion of each breed of the youth shows.

The week of animal shows is rounded out on Sunday, August 15 at 10 a.m. with the Draft Horse Show. Also on Sunday is a horseshoe pitching tournament and a gospel music performance

in the afternoon.

Pick up a schedule, or watch and listen to the news media. There's sure to be something you'll enjoy at the Tioga County Fair.

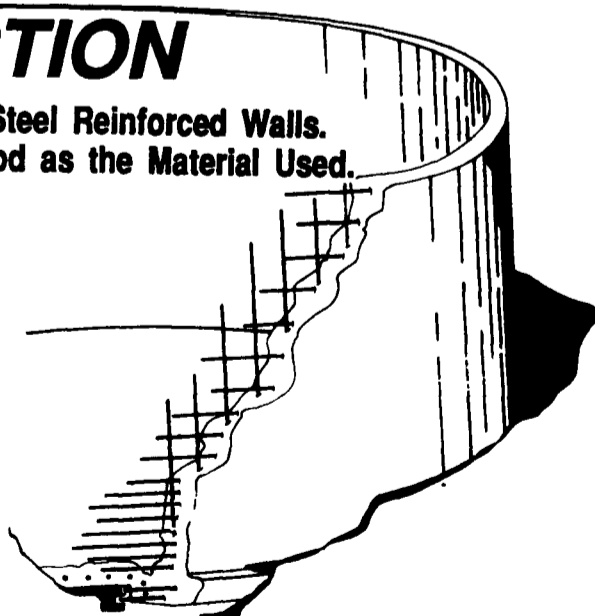
