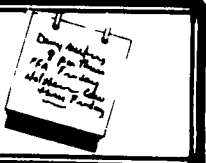

titis, or may otherwise be sick. The system integrates especially

well with Dairy Comp 305 and, when used in combination, can pro-

vide extraordinary information to better manage the dairy herd.
