(Continued from Page A33) studies in the mid-1980s which reflect what kinds of management techniques are necessary depending on varied herd sizes.

But many of the techniques Gamroth will demonstrate come as a result of what is learned at the milking schools conducted yearly by the Oregon State extension offices. The schools, which run over two days, show herd owners and employees the proper procedures before milking. The schools also explain what the somatic cell count is, how mastitis originates, and how to properly treat and manage related herd health problems.

"The schools explain more the 'why' of things rather than the 'how," said Gamroth.






