

Cattlemen's Field Days Set

PORT MATILDA (Centre Co.) — The Pennsylvania Cattlemen's Association will co-sponsor two field days in mid- and late-July. The July 24 field day will be at ErReR Hill Farm, Friedens (Somerset County), Pa. ErReR Hill Farm is owned by Sidney Riggs and managed by Bob Hay, who is also vice president of the Pennsylvania Cattlemen's Association.

The Field Day will be co-sponsored by the Somerset County Cattlemen and the Pennsylvania Angus Association.

There will be tours of several interesting cattle and land management practices at the ErReR Farm Field Day, emphasizing conservation practices which not only enhance soil and land conservation, but that also contribute to more productive and efficient cattle management. The tours will include stream bank protection, grazing systems, and other practical land management methods.

The program will include presentations by Dick Spader, executive secretary of the American Angus Association; Burton Eller, executive vice president of the National Cattlemen's Association in Washington, D.C.; Drs. Erskine Cash and John Comerford, Department of Dairy and Animal Science, Penn State University; and several Soil Conservation Service specialists.

There will also be commercial exhibitors with equipment, services, and products for field day

participants to view and discuss. ErReR Hill Farm is primarily a purebred Angus operation with 200 mature cows, but also finishes cattle for market.

The Somerset Cattlemen's Association will provide the lunch with the help of the cosponsors.

Association Field Day on July 17, also cosponsored by the Pennsylvania Cattlemen's Association will be at Ken Faust's Hidden Oaks Farm near Gettysburg (Adams County), Pa. The Adams County Cattlemen's Association will also be involved in helping to host the event. The Simmental Association/PCA Field Day will include many youth activities, which are always popular with both youth and adults.

We have also had many representatives from magazines and newspapers at these events — it has been an educational and enjoyable time for everyone," according to Dr. Lowell L. College Plans Field Day

NEWARK, Del. — The College of Agricultural Sciences at the University of Delaware has expanded Farm and Home Field Day on Wednesday, Aug. 11 to an all-day format.

The grounds of the Research and Education Center on Route 9 just west of Georgetown will be open from 8:30 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. with exhibits, demonstrations, and tours for homeowners and farmers.

Wagon tours in the morning and afternoon will highlight environmentally compatible agriculture, with a focus on agronomic and vegetable research as well as woodlot and wildlife conservation. As part of a safety program, visitors can be screened for their cholesterol count, hear a dermatologist discuss skin cancer and safe-sun practices, and learn about protective equipment used in agricultural production.

To entertain the children, field day will feature a petting zoo and facts on agriculture from costumed characters.

Throughout the day a lawn and garden expo will focus on how to correctly calibrate lawn and garden spreaders that are used for fertilizers and pesticides, how to use soil test results, and how to install a lawn irrigation system. Consumer and commodity groups will staff informational booths. In addition, commercial exhibitors will present ongoing demonstrations of new spray techniques for agronomic and vegetable crops.

Through improved training and communications with the nearly 200 field staff employees, Bigelow

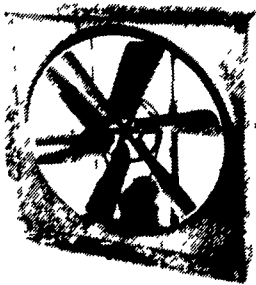

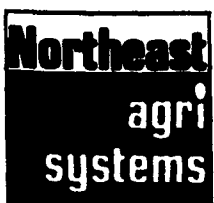
